

Class Expectations and Commitment

To make the most of our time together, commit to following this list:

1. Focus on YOUR growth, you are responsible for YOU. You are not here to change your partner.
2. Only you can do the work - you will truly get out of this what you choose to put into it.
3. Be honest and transparent. Participate.
4. Share openly with each other's permission. Do not share things to hurt or embarrass.
5. Show respect for others' opinions and feelings.
6. Confidentiality is required. Do not discuss particulars with anyone outside class.
7. Attendance is mandatory. If you miss, you are responsible to contact the teaching couple for the week you missed to schedule a one-on-one make up time as soon as possible.
8. You have weekly study material necessary for your relational growth and communication. Look at it as date night material!
9. Teachers are not counselors, but we are well-trained mentors who offer tools, skills, resources, and experience for your growth.
10. If there are specific current issues such as: substance abuse, infidelity, physical abuse, mental illness, etc. We would ask that you speak to a teacher immediately to decide if this is the right class to attend.
11. Pastor Erik Ireland is our overseeing pastor.
12. Commit to pray each day FOR your partner and grow into praying each day WITH your partner.
